On behalf of the 740 members of the New England Ophthalmological Society, and approximately 350 attendees of our New England Ophthalmic Medical Personnel (OMP) meeting, I would like to take this opportunity to thank the exhibitors who have supported our Society.

History and Statistics of NEOS Meetings

The New England Ophthalmological Society is the oldest ophthalmological society in the Western Hemisphere: our meeting in September will be our 751th meeting. The average attendance for meetings of the past five years has been over 300 per meeting. Attendance at our combined meeting with ophthalmic medical personnel and office administrators at the Hynes Convention Center on December 13, 2013, was 650.

New England Ophthalmic Medical Personnel Meetings

The NEOS sponsors an annual meeting for ophthalmic medical personnel. These meetings are held in conjunction with our scientific session. Our meeting has the second highest attendance after the Academy meeting for OMPs. The program containing outlines of each presentation will include a listing of exhibitors and one sentence advertisement of their product.

Meeting for Ophthalmologists' Office Managers and Support Personnel

NEOS conducts a concurrent meeting for ophthalmologists' office managers and personnel annually. The goal of the meeting is to familiarize support personnel in our member's practices with administrative, business and technology issues important to the conduct of an ethical and efficient practice.

Subspecialty Meetings

You must pay by credit card (MasterCard or Visa) for any meetings you select online. Payment must be in full, no partial payments can be accepted online.

Deposits

A deposit in the amount of 50% of the total exhibiting fee will be accepted when registering for three or more meetings with final payment due **January 1, 2015**. Registration for one or two meetings will require payment in full 30 days prior to the meeting date. Due to the limitations of space, a table will not be held without a deposit.

Cancellation of Exhibit Space

Notification of an exhibitor's decision to cancel assigned exhibit space must be submitted in writing. Exhibitors may cancel their participation without penalty up to 60 days prior to the meeting; cancellation received 30-60 days prior to the meeting will be subject to a 50% penalty; cancellation less than 30 days prior to the meeting is subject to a 100% penalty. The penalty amount will be based on fee paid, (i.e., amount paid for an individual meeting, or less 15% per meeting if registered for all five.)
